### Logging into KAMPUS e-learning university platform

#### Step 1.

Enter the website: <https://kampus.come.uw.edu.pl/>

Switch to the English language mode by choosing *English (en)* from the unfolding list in the top-right hand corner of the website.



#### Step 2.

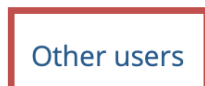
Create a new account.

Click *Log in* in the top right-hand corner next to the language choice option.



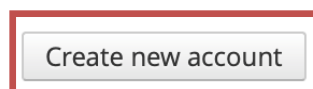
Choose *Other users* in the authentication choice.

#### Step 4.

Now click on:

##### Central Foreign Language Proficiency Examination at the University of Warsaw

- The candidate registers on the *Kampus* platform.
- The candidate pays CFLPE fee in the amount of 450 PLN to the following bank account: 500-D307-12-3070000. Transfer title must include the candidate's first and family names, email address and a note CFLPE.
- The candidate uploads their Personal Statement on the platform, which is the necessary prerequisite for being allowed to take the examination. Personal Statement must be submitted 7 days prior to the date of the examination at the latest.
- The candidate chooses the date and the form of the examination. The day and time of the exam must be chosen by the candidate 7 days in advance. Online examinations: Fridays from 10 a.m. Central European Time. Face-to-face examinations for candidates from Warsaw and its neighbourhood: Mondays from 10 a.m. in the building of the Centre for Foreign Language Teaching UW at the following address: ul. Nowy Świat 69, room 30.
- The oral examination, either face-to-face or online interview, lasts 30 minutes. At the beginning of the exam the candidate must show the examiners their ID with their photo for identification. The description of the exam is accessible at: (link). In case of technical problems during the online exam exceeding 10 minutes, the examination is cancelled and the new date of the examination is arranged.
- The candidate's statement of result (satisfactory/unsatisfactory) is released online on the platform within 3 days after the exam.
- The candidate generates their CFLPE statement of result from the platform.
